Position Description

Vision IT has an immediate opportunity as an Information Assurance Engineer located at Ft. Huachuca in Sierra Vista AZ. This position will support the U.S. Army. You will provide operational cybersecurity support by developing and analyzing both DoD Information Assurance Certification and Accreditation Process (DIACAP) and Risk Management Framework (RMF) packages, ensuring systems meet Army, DISA, and NIST 800-53 standards. You will be responsible for evaluating the overall security posture of systems, to include documentation, processes, procedures, and system security architectural design, addressing and remediating security gaps. Excellent verbal and written communication skills required.

Job Description:

- Carries out information systems security assessments and analysis. Analyze DIACAP and Risk Management Framework (RMF) Executive Packages, including POA&M, Functional Architecture Diagrams, and Certifying Authority Recommendations
- Conducts reviews to ensure that systems are operating securely and that information systems security policies and procedures are being implemented as defined in security plans
- Safeguards the network against unauthorized infiltration, modification, destruction, or disclosure.
- Evaluates, communicates and research security policies or plans for data, software applications, hardware, telecommunications, and information systems security education/awareness programs.
- Responds to queries and requests for computer security information and reports
- Provides solutions to a variety of technical problems of moderate scope and complexity
- Demonstrates well-developed communication skills.
