The selected candidate(s) will provide network design, engineering, and implementation services in support of the Army's Network Modernization (NETMOD) to the Joint Regional Security Stack (JRSS). The Network Engineer will be responsible for troubleshooting network-related issues, providing solutions and updating stakeholders. The selected candidate(s) must have a thorough understanding of complex network architectural design, to include routing and switching technologies (i.e. VRF, MPLS, VPN, BGP, ACLs, firewall policies and other LAN/WAN principles). In addition, knowledge and experience with DoD security policies and procedures highly desired.

This position is located in Fort Huachuca, AZ; some relocation assistance, while not guaranteed, may be available.

- Comprehensive knowledge of Layer 3 Routing
- Support BGP, VRF, VLAN, MPLS, ACL, VPN and load balancing technologies
- Experience with FW, TLA and LAN & WAN migrations a plus
- In-depth knowledge cyber security standards
- Strong Network troubleshooting skills (DoD Network Policies is a plus)
